Essential Duties & Responsibilities: Other duties may be assigned.

- Deliver quality product to the customer in efficient, timely and professional manner.
- Drives truck to location for unloading.
- Uses controls on truck and/or remote to move boom safely and place and/or set product into place for customer.
- Cleans truck after delivery to maintain cleanliness.
- May drive other equipment if demand requires.
- Traveling to other plant locations.
- Misc. projects helping around the yard as needed.
- May operate loader.
- Work with in all safety procedures.
- Comply with all company policies.
- DVIR's daily and Log books.
- Complete delivery ticket with necessary information.

Supervisory Responsibilities: None

<u>Qualifications</u>: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.

• Preferably driven off-road equipment, log truck, concrete mixer and/or boom truck.

Education and Experience:

Six months - One year related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Language Skills:

Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals. Ability to write routine reports and correspondence. Ability to speak effectively before groups of customers or employees of organization.

Mathematical Skills:

Ability to add and subtract two digit numbers and to multiply and divide with 10's and 100's. Ability to perform these operations using units of American money and weight measurement, volume, and distance.

Reasoning Ability:

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out detailed but uninvolved written or oral instructions. Able to deal with problems involving a few variables in standardized situations.

Certificates, Licenses and Registrations:

Must have a valid CDL A - clean license DOT Medical Card current while employed. <u>Physical Demands</u>: The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee may be regularly required to sit and talk or hear. The employee frequently may be required to walk; use hands to finger, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl. The employee is occasionally required to stand. The employee may regularly lift and/or move up to 65 to 100 pounds, frequently lift and/or move up to 25 pounds, and occasionally lift and/or move up to 10 pounds.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee may be regularly exposed to dust or dirt particles and other outside weather conditions. The employee may be frequently exposed to moving mechanical parts; high, precarious places; and vibration. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.

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
